DIRECTIONS TO ST. MARY'S

We strongly recommend car-pooling. See website for map and link to directions:

- St. Mary's is about 93 miles from downtown Nashville and it takes about an hour and a half to make the drive
- Take I-24 East from Nashville.
- From where I-40 E feeds into I-24 E, it is about 83.0 miles.
- Take exit 134 for US 41A toward Sewanee/ Monteagle, go .2 miles.
- Turn left at W Main St/TN-15/TN-56/US-41 and continue to follow TN-15/TN-56/US-41 for approx. 5.6 miles.
- Turn left at Sherwood Rd/TN-56 and go
- 1.0 mile.
- Turn right at St Mary's Lane
- Destination will be on the right in 0.6 mi

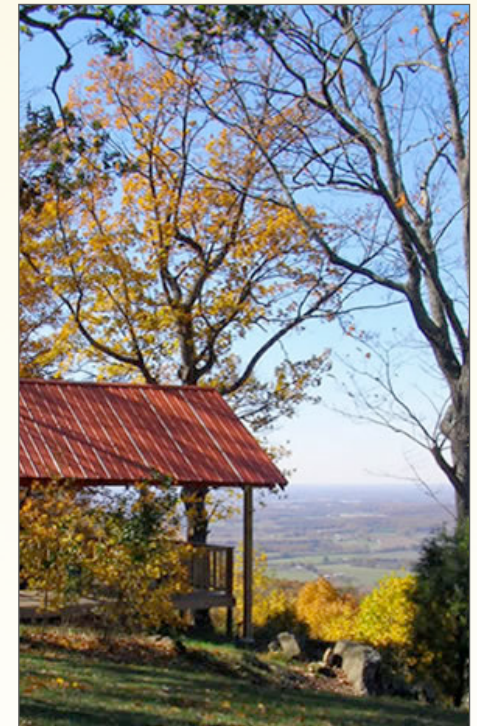

The Rev. Timothy Jones is a noted author and retreat leader and serves as Senior Associate Rector at St. George's Episcopal Church in Nashville, overseeing adult Christian discipleship. He has written several acclaimed books on the spiritual life, including Workday Prayers, Nurturing Your Child's Soul, and The Art of Prayer: A Simple Guide to Conversation with God. He is a graduate of Princeton Theological Seminary and The School of Theology at the University of the South, Sewanee. He is a former editor for Christianity Today magazine.

The Rev. Jill Zook-Jones is a priest in the diocese of Tennessee, having served St John the Evangelist, St. Bartholomew's, and St. Joseph of Arimathea churches. She served in the diocesan office for seven years, first as coordinator of youth ministry and then Canon to the Ordinary for Bishop Herlong. She attended Princeton Theological Seminary and is a graduate of the School of Theology of the University of the South, Sewanee. She and husband Tim co-authored the study guide, Prayer: Understanding What Scripture Teaches.
